- 1. Openable objects (with a hinge+lock):
 - Medallions & Pendants
 - Souvenirs
 - Decorative elements









HOLLOW FORMS. DESIGN VARIATIONS:

- 2. Non-openable objects:
 - Beads
 - Pendants
 - Parts of the big object (bracelet, etc.)
 - Decorative elements









HOLLOW FORMS. WHAT'S INSIDE?

- Burnable base (organic base)
- Removable base (model or tool to fix a shape)
- Nothing (element assembled by hand)



HOLLOW FORMS. Burnable base (organic):

- WOOD wood clay powder
- CORK cork clay brick
- PAPER MACHE (paper mass)







HOLLOW FORMS. Removable base & tools:

- PLASTIC-GLASS-WOOD-METAL BASE
- POLYMER CLAY AND OTHER HOBBY CLAYS
- "POLYMORPHUS"








MASTERCLASS




1. Forming first element (repeat 2 times)



- 2. Drying first element (repeat 2 times) + making a bail
- 3. Assembling a ball



- 4. Sanding a ball + carving
- 5. Bail fixing on a top of a ball



- 6. Final check, bronze recycling, preparing for firing (ceramic fiber blanket)
- 7. Cleaning, sanding and polishing.
